**Experimental Day:** On the 14<sup>th</sup> of November Penny McWilliams hosted an Experimental Day



at Heathhall showing members how to construct lace using a sewing machine. Members learnt how the lace is sewn onto water soluble stabiliser which is then washed completely away to leave their beautiful designs.

**Rug Tufting:** On the 21<sup>st</sup> of November we welcomed Laura Derby to give us a talk entitled 'Hidden Lines – rug tufting'. Laura creates unique, hand-crafted textile rugs, wall hangings,



mindfulness mats and upholstered stools made by skilled local woodworkers. The hand tufting technique allows Laura to paint and sculpt with yarn and artfully weave elements of the natural world and heritage motifs. Most stools she upholsters are from local storm fallen trees. She says tufting with her tufting gun is like her personal fight to try to steer things right in this world that she loves, with strengthening links between art, nature and humanity towards greater psychological and cultural health very important to her.
